

ARTS & CRAFT ESCAPE IN SIEM REAP, 4 days / 3 nights

DAY 1: SIEM REAP ARRIVAL, NATIONAL MUSEUM AND CIRCUS SHOW

Upon arrival, welcome by the local guide at Siem Reap airport, transfer and check-in at the hotel.

Note: Rooms are available from 2pm.


In the afternoon, visit the National Museum to discover the history of the famous Khmer Empire and Angkor; ideal to start a journey to the heart of an ancient civilization with exceptional heritage.

Early evening, enjoy a surprising circus show combining creativity, energy and originality, all acquired from the Khmer culture.

Overnight in Siem Reap.

DAY 2: SIEM REAP: POTTERY CLASS & VISIT AN ARTIST'S STUDIO

(B/L)



After breakfast, transfer to the Centre of Khmer Ceramics, dedicated to the revival of the traditional Ceramic art. During the class, one will learn how to use the potter's wheel or clay modelling by hand. Once the clay has been crafted, it will be fired and later delivered to its artist.

Note: The crafted pottery will be delivered within 24-hour. It is also possible to finish several others during the class (with supplement to be paid on the spot).

Lunch at local restaurant.

In the afternoon, visit Angkor Wat (early-mid 12th century) dedicated to the Hindu god Vishnu. This huge temple-mountain, built by King Suryavarman II, is considered as the masterpiece of the Khmer architecture and art. Later, visit a local artist's studio.

Overnight in Siem Reap.

Note: If the visit falls on a Buddhist religious day (about 4 or 5 days per month), the visit of Angkor Wat should be postponed to another day in order to visit its 3rd floor.

DAY 3: SIEM REAP: GOLDEN SILK & CABARET SHOW

(B/L)

After breakfast, drive to the famous Bantey Srey Temple the "Citadel of Women". This small pink sandstone temple (late 10th century) is considered to be the jewel in a crown of classical Khmer art because of its delicate carvings.

Then, return back to Siem Reap through the Cambodian countryside. On the way, stop and visit a golden silk workshop to discover this forgotten craft. From the region of Lake Tonle these silkworms naturally produce a yellow-gold colour used since the 13th century in the Khmer traditional crafts.

Lunch at local restaurant.

In the afternoon, discover the fascinating Ta Phrom Temple, probably one of the most famous monuments with Angkor Wat and the Bayon. This former monastery is still surrounded by the jungle.

The early evening is dedicated to a cabaret worthy of the great performances of Broadway.

DAY 4: SIEM REAP

(B)

After breakfast, visit the ancient capital of Angkor Thom, a huge architectural complex with the famous Bayon Temple at its centre. This mountain-temple was once surrounded by 54 towers. On each of the 37 remaining, 4 enigmatic faces can still be recognized. Then, explore Baphuon, which was fully restored by a team of French archaeologists after 16 years of work.

Return to Siem Reap in the late morning.

Note: Rooms shall be released by 12pm (noon).

Depending on the flight schedule, transfer to the airport for the departure flight.
