



IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF THE CHAMPA KINGDOM

4 days / 3 nights

D1 HOI AN (L)

Explore the famous Old Quarter of Hoi An. This is an exceptionally well-preserved example of a South-East Asian trading port dating from the 15th to the 19th century. City tour among its narrow streets lined with traditional houses and its most significant monuments such as the Japanese bridge or Phuc Kien Pagoda.

Discover a workshop where visitors can try their hand at the delicate task of making lanterns, a symbol of the city.

In the afternoon, enjoy an excursion by boat on the Thu Bon River with a stop, along the way, at a traditional ceramic and carpentry village.

The rest of the day is at leisure to enjoy the old city or the beach (if weather permits).

Overnight in Hoi An.

D2 HOI AN–MY SON–HOI AN (B/L)

After breakfast, depart for an excursion to My Son, a cluster of abandoned and partially ruined Hindu temples constructed between the 4th and the 14th century AD by the kings of Champa, a once powerful Hindu empire. Spend the morning touring the most significant archaeological ruins of Vietnam, listed as a World Heritage site by UNESCO.

Return back to Hoi An by late-morning and lunch at local restaurant.

The afternoon is at leisure in the ancient city.

Overnight in Hoi An.



D3 HOI AN–DANANG–HUE (B/L)

After breakfast, depart to Hue, the ancient capital of Vietnam under the Nguyen Dynasty via Hai Van pass and Danang. On the way, visit the famous Cham Museum, housing a unique collection about the history of the Champa civilization.

In the afternoon, resume the journey toward Hue and check-in at the hotel upon arrival. Then, explore Hue, listed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO.

Discover the Imperial City, the former imperial seat of government. This is a great sprawling complex of temples, pavilions, moats, walls, gates, shops, museums and galleries, featuring art and costumes from various periods of Vietnamese history.

Then visit the Celestial Lady pagoda, one of the most venerated sites in the city of Hue.

Overnight in Hue.

D4 HUE (B)



After breakfast, visit the mausoleum of Emperor Minh Mang and the tomb of Emperor Tu Duc, the 4th emperor of the Nguyen Dynasty of Vietnam, who reigned from 1847–1883. The buildings and gardens have been shaped according to the directives of geomancy (Feng Shui). Together, they form a huge park where the beauty nature is everywhere.

Last stop at villages to see how conical hats and incense sticks are made.

Return to hotel in the late morning and free time at leisure. Note: Rooms shall be released by 12pm (noon).

Depending on the flight schedule, transfer to Hue’s airport for the departure flight.
